

2015 RCFA Sale Guidelines

Steers

6 Total Classes – 20 Sale Spots

The number of exotic classes compared to American classes will be determined by the percentage of Americans that classify. The number of sale spots in each breed will be based on the same percentage.

Example: Assume there are 40 total steers (10 Americans and 30 Exotics). The Americans account for 25% of the total entries and will therefore account for 25% of the sale spots (5). The Exotics account for 75% of the total entries and will account for 75% of the sale spots (15). There is an attached spreadsheet that further explains this process.

Lambs

5 Total Classes – 25 Sale Spots – 5 sell in each class

The judge will rank the classes from strongest to weakest at the conclusion of the show. The ranking as well as class placing will determine your spot within the sale order including the alternates. All animals will sell in the order of their placing and will not move up to a higher placing slot in the case of other animals dropping out of the sale order in that class.

Goats

4 Total Classes – 20 Sale Spots – 5 sell in each class

The judge will rank the classes from strongest to weakest at the conclusion of the show. The ranking as well as class placing will determine your spot within the sale order including the alternates. All animals will sell in the order of their placing and will not move up to a higher placing slot in the case of other animals dropping out of the sale order in that class.

Swine

5 Total Classes – 30 Sale Spots – 6 sell in each class

The judge will rank the classes from strongest to weakest at the conclusion of the show. The ranking as well as class placing will determine your spot within the sale order including the alternates. All animals will sell in the order of their placing and will not move up to a higher placing slot in the case of other animals dropping out of the sale order in that class.

Chickens

15 Pens Sell -- Pens will sell in the order of their placing by the judge.

Turkeys

6 Pens Sell -- Pens will sell in the order of their placing by the judge.

Rabbits

10 Pens Sell -- Pens will sell in the order of their placing by the judge.

**** 4.50 or more rounds up to 5 classes and 4.49 or less rounds down to 4 classes of Exotics
